

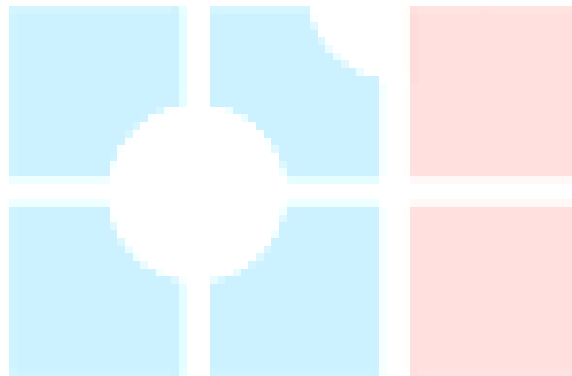

SPEAKER'S PROFILE

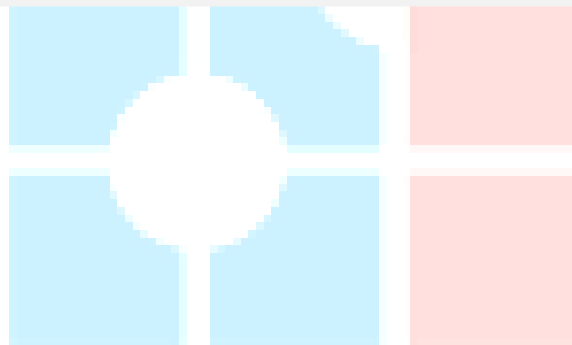
